Sing along to your favourite song	Teach your family the “don’t clap this one back” game	Find 6 household objects that make an interesting sound	Make an instrument out of items in your house	Play on a Music app on your device

Talk to someone in your family about their favourite music	If you have a garden, find 5 different ways to make a sound with a stick	Draw a picture of your favourite instrument	Take your favourite toy on a sound adventure	Watch some ballet on youtube
Sing in the shower or bath, as loudly as you can!	Learn a new clapping game/song. Your grown-up might know some from when they were at school!	Sing a song you learned in school to a grown-up	Watch a musical film	Bounce a ball in time to the beat of a song
Fill a bottle with water. Gently blow over the top to make a sound. Experiment with different amounts of water.	Write a list of all the musical words you know. These can be instruments, loud, quiet etc.	Take your toy on sound adventure. How many different sounds can you make and hear?	Make up a song about your most recent class topic to help you remember the facts	Use some household objects to create an “Under the Sea” soundscape. You could use tinfoil, bubble wrap etc.
Draw or paint a picture. Make up a song or compose some music about it. Use household objects, pasta shakers, metal spoons etc. if you haven’t got a musical instrument at home.
