Talk to someone in your family about their favourite music	Practise an instrument	Research and make a poster about a famous composer	Learn some beatboxing or rapping skills	Watch some ballet on youtube
Sing in the shower, as loudly as you can!	Invent 4 new rhythms	Sing a song you learned in school to a grown-up	Watch a musical film	Bounce a ball in time to the beat of a song
Find out about the composer William Walton. Where was he born?	Write a list of all the musical vocabulary you know	Try some chair drumming. You could use wooden spoons if you haven't got drumsticks	Make up a song about your most recent class topic to help you remember the facts	Use some household objects to create a Rainforest soundscape. You could use tinfoil, bubble wrap etc.
Draw or paint a picture. Make up a song or compose some music about it. Use household objects, pasta shakers, metal spoons etc. if you haven't got a musical instrument at home.	Create an 8-beat pattern using body percussion	Make up a song to help you remember your 4 times table	Listen to a piece of music from a different country	Design a poster to advertise a concert at your school
